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



#### Planning and Development Updates

#### The Guidebook for Great Communities

My comments on the Guidebook are written a month before the City of Calgary Administration is scheduled to report to Council's planning committee on May 5, 2021. Administration was directed to prepare a summary of what was presented at the Public Hearing in March, and to bring forward proposed amendments to the Guidebook based on the public's input.

Throughout April, there was ongoing dialogue on amendments with representative stakeholders, but I have not seen any efforts to dialogue with citizens. The lack of direct conversations with citizens has led to a lot of fear and misunderstanding, and thus, opposition.

As I indicated in an earlier e-newsletter, I think most concerns around the status of single-family housing and the transition between existing housing and higher buildings or commercial nodes would be addressed if the Guidebook were adopted as a policy rather than a statutory document. Hopefully by the time you see this article we will know the answer to that issue.

With or without an approved Guidebook, Parkdale residents are invited to participate in developing our own vision for growth and change in our community. You may have attended the AGM on April 22 when we outlined our process. Watch for an invitation to participate in future newsletters, in our e-newsletter, and when we deliver information to your home or business.

The Guidebook for Great Communities is a good document and gives guidance for growth and change.

The principles are: Opportunity and Choice, Health and Wellness, Social Interaction, The Natural Environment, Economic Vitality, Identity and Place. You can find more information at www. calgary.ca by typing The Guidebook for Great Communities into the search box.

#### Other news:

- Construction of the upgrade of the power plant at Foothills Medical Campus is underway. This spring the site will be cleared, and the required new piles will be installed between mid-May and mid-June. The latter is intended to be completed using drill technology rather than "driving/ pounding".
- •The new Cancer Centre is 70% complete and substantial completion is expected by the end of 2022.
- The process to redevelop Foothills Athletic Park is underway.
   Watch for opportunities to participate in surveys and charettes.

#### Vehicle theft and car prowling prevention:

- Garage openers should not be left in vehicles, or should be disengaged, as thieves can use them to gain entry into a home.
- Avoid parking in unlit areas at night.
- Lock your doors and close all windows at all times, even while you are in your yard.
- Hide your valuables out of sight, or better yet, take them with you.
- Don't keep extra keys in your vehicle.
- If you park your vehicle in a parkade, be sure that you do not let anyone else in who doesn't belong when you are entering and exiting.
- Report any suspicious activity or behaviour, such as someone trying door handles on parked vehicles.

#### Home and garage break-in prevention:

- Offenders will often break into a residence as a way to steal a vehicle parked outside the residence. When you're at home, store your vehicle keys away from the entrance to your house.
- Consider installing home and vehicle alarm systems and vehicle anti-theft devices.
- Ensure that all doors and windows are secured at all times, even when you're home. Culprits need mere moments to commit a theft or break in. If you do open any windows or doors, make sure you only open them for rooms that someone is present in.
- Report any suspicious people or activity in your community by calling 403-266-1234 or 9-1-1 if there is a crime in progress.



#### **Protecting Lives and Livelihoods**

As the MLA for Calgary-Varsity, I was pleased to take part in the announcement of \$23 million to expand the neonatal ICU at the Foothills hospital. This investment will support fragile newborns and families in Southern Alberta. It is also exciting to see the progress that is being made at the Calgary Cancer Centre, a \$1.4 billion investment that is on time and on budget.

These two initiatives at the Foothills campus are in addition to the nearly \$21 billion investment over three years under the 2021 Capital Plan, all aimed to create thousands of jobs and protect livelihoods.
