Meeting Special Rules

Purpose: Special Rules are a common and useful parliamentary method for the Membership to clarify key rules and understandings in order to make the meeting efficient and fair for all Members.

Approval: These proposed Special Rules are subject to the approval of the Membership. A vote of 2/3 or more in favour is required to adopt these rules for the meeting. If approved, the rules can be further modified by the Membership at any time during the meeting with a 2/3 vote in favour to amend.

- 1. A member seeking recognition to speak will raise their hand and, when recognized, will say their name before speaking.
- 2. Members may only speak twice in debate on any motion and for no more than two minutes per speaking time.
- 3. Debate is always through the Chair and must be respectful at all times. Debate must always relate to the pending motion.
- 4. Nominations
 - a. A list of candidates who have submitted their names in advance will be presented to the Members
 - b. Additional nominations from the floor may be made.
- 5. Election of Board of Directors
 - a. Tellers
 - i. The Members will appoint two persons to serve as Tellers for the election.
 - b. Non-Contested Elections (the exact or less number of nominees than available positions)
 - i. Nominees will be elected by acclamation without the need for a vote.
 - c. Contested Elections (more than the number of nominees for available position(s))
 - i. Contested elections will be conducted by secret ballot.
 - ii. The Tellers will count the ballots.
 - iii. The person receiving the most votes will be elected. If there is a tie for the most votes, the ballot will be repeated up to two more times. If the vote is still tied after three ballots, a name will be drawn at random to determine the winner.
